



2012 CCSKC / NSWSKC Speedway Kart Interclub Challenge

- Purpose:**
- * The 2012 rule book is now a standard for all speedway clubs
 - * The aim is to get drivers racing together at different events, held by different clubs, at different venues
 - * This will promote goodwill between all the clubs and drivers
 - * And will provide additional recognition for those racing and leading the Interclub Challenge
- Format:**
- * Four club championship rounds will be used :
 - Feb 19 at NSWSKC Round 1
 - Apr 15 at CCSKC Round 3
 - July 1 at NSWSKC Round 5 (Long Track)
 - July 15 at CCSKC Round 5 (Alan Hann Memorial)(In the event of any wash-out, the meeting will move accordingly)
 - * Drivers racing at these club rounds will qualify to enter the Interclub Challenge, but you must race at all four rounds.
 - * Classes we anticipate to be competing are:
 - Cadets, Rookies, Juniors, Clubman Light, Clubman Heavy, KT Light, KT Heavy/Pro, Sportsman 125.
 - * There should be a minimum of 5 entries per class.
 - * Each club will supply key officials for each of these club rounds to ensure fairness and equity for all.
 - * Prestigious trophies will be provided to the winners in each class, after the final round. These will be provided by all clubs participating.

Pointscore System:

* The Interclub Challenge works using its own point score system. This will be calculated (and verified) for each competitor at the conclusion of each meeting, based on their race results.

* Total points available over four rounds = 1,000

* Each round will be worth 250 points maximum.
