New South Wales Speedway Kart Club Inc. By Laws 6th December 2011 (changes appear in red)

Additional in-house rules (to be read in conjunction with the New South Wales Speedway Kart Club Inc. constitution) for the members of the NSW Speedway Kart Club Inc.

1. Speedway Kart Racing Rules

- 1) Rules governing Speedway Kart racing are as per Chapter 48 of the AKA Manual

2. Membership Fees

- 1) The annual subscription to the club, for both racing and non-racing members, will be determined by a majority vote of members present at a meeting called to discuss such and may be varied from time to time.
- 2) Subscriptions fall due on the first day of January each year. Any member not paid up by the first day of February will be declared non-financial and will lose all entitlements to voting racing and other of the club's functions or activities.
- 3) Membership fees will be as per the following schedules a) & b)
 - a) The annual membership fees of the club will apply from 1st January until 31st December and will be:-
 - i) Active racing competitors
 - 1) Family* (includes dependent children under 18/active or social) - **\$90.00**
 - 2) Senior (licence holder 18 and over) - **\$60.00**
 - 3) Junior (licence holder 7 to 17 incl) - **\$60.00**
 - ii) Non-active competitors
 - 1) Family* (non-racing) - **\$45.00**
 - 2) Single Person (non-racing) - **\$30.00**

*Family membership consists of a senior member, their spouse and dependent children under the age of 18 only.

b) Persons who join the club throughout the year will be entitled to a reduction of membership fees:-

- i) 1st June to 31st August 50% **reduction*
- ii) 1st September to 31st December 75% **reduction*

* Calculations to be rounded to the nearest dollar.

3. Racing Numbers

- 1) A competing racing financial member may apply for permanent racing numbers for their use in their nominated class for one (1) membership year with the following one (1) year option.
- 2) A number will be allotted by the executive from those numbers that are vacant at the time of having their membership accepted with the number 1 being awarded to the reigning NSWKC Club Champion
- 3) Numbers are issued from 0 to 99 per class with number 1 being reserved for the reigning NSWKC, Club Champion.

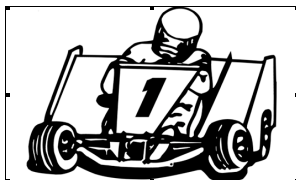

4. Number Plates

- 1) Refer to AKA Karting Manual rule 25.13 Number Plates, sections (i), (ii) & (vii) and AKA Karting Manual rule 48.09 Kart Numbers.
- 2) The winner of each class at the NSW State Speedway Title is eligible to carry a special coloured rear number plate with their current racing number until the conclusion of the following State Titles.
- 3) The winner of each class at the Australian Speedway Title is eligible to carry a special coloured rear number plate with their current racing number until the conclusion of the following Australian Title.
- 4) Number plates and all numbers must be clean for all races

5. Club and Class Championship Qualification

- 1) All competitors will be rostered to act as a volunteer in the running of a race meeting.
- 2) All competitors under the age of 18 years shall have a parent/guardian perform their duties. The competitor may compete for no points to the championship, but only for that days racing.
- 3) Competitors must complete volunteer duties as rostered.
- 4) A minimum five (5) volunteers will be required to run each meeting (more may be selected at the discretion of the club executive)
- 5) Volunteers may be rostered to assist non-competition club events (at the discretion of the club executive)
- 6) Drivers will only be required to complete one (1) volunteer day per competition season.
- 7) Qualified competitors may fulfil volunteer obligations by acting as a representative of the Australian Karting Association (AKA), (i.e., Steward, Clerk of Course etc) to assist in the running of a race meeting.
- 8) The rostered competitor must complete a volunteer day to qualify for any class or club championship.
- 9) All volunteers will be awarded 100 points for their completed volunteer duty on their rostered day. Points are awarded as follows
 - a. 25pts for attending briefing and roll call on time at 8.15am
 - b. 25pts for assisting with the track and equipment set up as instructed
 - c. 25pts for satisfactory completing the duty assigned for the day by clerk of course
 - d. 25pts for assisting with the pack up of track and equipment as instructed
- 10) A change of official's day must be made in writing to the club executive, a minimum of 14 days prior to the day allocated, for consideration.
- 11) In the event of a meeting being cancelled with less than 2 rounds completed, all volunteers will be re-appointed to the replacement race date at the discretion of the club executive.
- 12) To qualify for a class championship a driver must compete in 50% of that classes
- 13) Allocated races for the year.

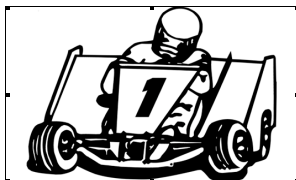

6. Club and Class Championship Point Score

- 1) Points are awarded from heats and final at each race meeting. All competitors' points are tallied to determine race day class winners and place getters.
- 2) If a meeting is abandoned, cancelled or altered after commencement, points gained will count towards class championship subject to completion of the minimum number of races across all classes entered on the day. (50% of fully completed scheduled racing)
- 3) A competitor must receive the checkered flag to be awarded points.
- 4) Points can be reduced by stewards where specified in the AKA manual, i.e. weights etc.
- 5) Close the Club and Class Championship point score publications after at the conclusion of round 5.
- 6) The NSWSKC Club and Class Championships will be conducted over an allocated and approved number of competition rounds as announced by each succeeding club executive.
- 7) The championship/s points will be calculated by subtracting the single lowest round from the total season points for each driver that has qualified
- 8) A minimum number of four (4) rounds of competition must be conducted and completed to constitute a competition for both club and class championships.

7. Club and Class Points Allocation

- 1) The point score is based on a 25-point system where if the pole kart wins they are awarded 25 points.
- 2) Points are won or lost for each position gained or lost during a race based on grid position and finishing position of each competitor.
- 3) The point score is subject to the following conditions: -
 - (a) Competitors must receive the checkered flag
 - (b) Points are subject to completion of a volunteer duty day
 - (c) If points are equal, dual winners will be declared, e.g. 2x1st is equal to 1st + 2x2nd
 - (d) Visitors compete for trophies on the day and are included in the field to determine finishing positions of club competitors.
 - (e) If a driver elects to start from rear of field after grids have been exhibited, or a competitor is placed there by official(s) (for a misdemeanour), points gained or lost will be determined from their original grid position, (not from rear starting position).
- 4) Points will be based on the table shown below
- 5) When any race is cancelled from the round due to safety, weather or force of nature every driver is awarded 25 points for that race, i.e. if two races cancelled 50 points allocated, if one race 25 points etc.

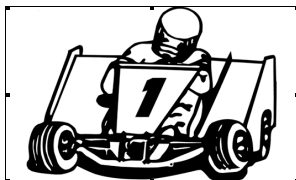
